The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has a requirement for hazardous fuels management services to treat vegetation to reduce the risk of wildland fires. Nevada is one of the states that may utilize contracts resulting from this Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract. Multiple awards are anticipated. This IDIQ Contract will be issued for a 3 year period. Other federal land management agencies may also utilize this contract.

Project areas may be reforestation areas, natural and managed stands of timber of all ages, size, and species, shrub fields, or grass areas. The objective is to treat fuels present on units identified to reduce fuel loading. The services are designed to provide for hazardous fuels reduction, prescribed burning and mop-up. Services may include furnishing labor, supervision, transportation, operating supplies and incidentals to perform all work necessary to conduct hazardous fuels reduction by manual, chemical, or mechanical methods.
