The Nevada Department of Agriculture is pleased to announce a Request for Proposals for noxious weed mapping and management projects. This funding source is designed to target on-the-ground control projects for CWMAs, Weed Districts and Tribes. These projects may be individual or part of a larger project. The funds are available to CWMAs, WDs and Tribes recognized by the Nevada Department of Agriculture. A total of \$125,000 is available and will be awarded until gone on a request by request basis (\$12,500 max request). Grants will be awarded by August 15 for use in the 2009—2010 field seasons.

Eligibility: All Cooperative Weed Management Areas, Weed Districts and Tribes recognized by the Nevada Department of Agriculture that are in good standing are invited to apply.

Criteria: Projects must directly control species on the State Noxious Weed List. Projects on either public or private lands are acceptable. There is a 50% in-kind Match Requirement. Proposals which do not follow the guidelines will be ineligible. **Funds must be expended by June 30, 2010. However, an extension through October 31, 2010 is possible.** A progress report will be due by December 31, 2009. The final report (including photo documentation of the project) is due by July 30, 2010 (or November 30, 2010) to the Nevada Department of Agriculture. A maximum 10% administrative/overhead fee is allowed.

Proposal Guidelines: Please submit a maximum two page proposal (plus a third page for the budget) to **Scott Marsh at the Nevada Department of Agriculture, 405 South 21st Street, Sparks, NV 89431. Proposals must be postmarked by August 15, 2009. Late proposals will not be accepted.**

Your proposal must include:

Organization Name, Contact Information and Date Submitted.

Financial Manager's Name and Tax ID#.

Project Description and Need (location, target species, control method, revegetation project, part of a larger project, etc...).

Project partners and their potential match contributions.

Specific budget page corresponding to the project description. The budget page may be in addition to the two pages of text.

Maps and photos are not required but permitted in the appendices and will be reviewed at the discretion of the reviewing committee. If you include these, you must label them as appendices.
